## **Auckland Regional Dental Service**

The mobile dental van will at school next term from Monday 22 May to Friday 2 June.

Following significant service disruption during the COVID-19 period, the Auckland Regional Dental Service (ARDS) is continuing to work through a catch-up recovery programme that supports equity for tamariki in accessing dental care. Their aim as part of this recovery programme is to deliver equitable service access for our tamariki/children. To do this, they will be increasing the frequency of their mobile dental facilities into and out of schools and focusing on examining and treating tamariki that they have identified as having higher dental needs and are most overdue. This means that not all tamariki will be seen on the mobile unit at the time of each planned visit.
